

AWARDS: BEST CLUB PERSON AWARD

This award is named "The Colin Fisher Memorial Award". It was named after Colin Fisher, a member now deceased, who continually served the club in a capacity beyond most and lived and breathed the club values.

This award is bestowed upon the member who, in the opinion of the Management Committee, has made the most significant contribution and service to the club, on and/or off the field during the season. It is generally awarded for off field contribution rather than on field contribution. It is also awarded to those who uphold the club values.

To receive this award the nominee should meet most or all of the following criteria:

- Follows, believes and promotes the core values of the club.
- · Demonstrates enormous commitment to the club in an official or unofficial capacity.
- Brings credibility and honour to the club.
- Regularly volunteers and assists in on-field and off-field activities and generously donates time to the club.
- · Is involved in and participates in fund raising activities for the club
- · Regularly attends official functions conducted by the club.
- · Makes financial commitments to the club over and above standard fees and obligations.
- Demonstrates excellent sportsmanship.

Eligibility:

MUST be a fully financial member of the club.

Nomination:

Nominations are sought from club members and Committee. The nomination must include commentary outlining why the individual should receive the award.

The Management Committee will convene and discuss each nomination, agree and vote on who ultimately is awarded Best Club Person award.

Those nominated but not selected can be referred as candidates for Recognition Awards.
